

Graffiti plagues Vista building

Truckee Meadows Community College Vista Building was defaced with graffiti during Sept. 8-9.

Graffiti is an ongoing problem, said Lt. Christopher Rossi of the TMCC Police

Department. According to the lieutenant, most campus graffiti either is a case of tagging or is gang-related.

Placing graffiti on or otherwise defacing property is a misdemeanor and can result in fines, penalties and the possible suspension of driver's license. Fines and

penalties will be the responsibility of the perpetrator's parent or guardian if he or she is younger than 18 years.
